WHEREAS, Mrs. Scott enjoys many hobbies, including crochet, travel and cooking some of the most delicious food to be found in Brooklyn; and

WHEREAS, This exceptional centenarian, with her zest for life, has inspired and enhanced the lives of her church, congregation and friends; and

WHEREAS, This distinguished woman has experienced the incredible joys and sorrows characteristic of and reserved for those with the stamina and courage to savor a full life; and

WHEREAS, This beloved woman has enriched the lives of those around her through her joyous and sincere love for others and through the quintessential charm and wisdom which comes only from a fullness of years; and
