We are writing in support of Brooklyn Community Board 3's request to revoke the liquor license of Amour Cabaret located at 566 Nostrand Avenue. We are extremely disturbed by the tragic incident of violence that claimed the life of a twenty-six year old man on March 3, 2020. This location has been the site of numerous reports of acts of violence as well as other dangerous and illegal activity.

It is because of this crime and others that have taken place in and around Amour Cabaret, and the management's apparent unwillingness to solve the problems that exist on their premises, that we fully support Brooklyn Community Board 3's request for the State Liquor Authority to revoke their liquor license.

We respectfully request that immediate action be taken to protect the community.
