MEDICARE CARD SCAM ALERT

Despite what scammers say, new Medicare cards are free. In order to eliminate the risk of identity theft, the government is in the process of replacing old Medicare cards, which contain a recipients Social Security number, with new cards that contain an 11-character identifier. The card is mailed automatically, so any call asking for personal information or proposing a fee to be paid is a scam. Suspicious calls can be reported by calling 1-800-MEDICARE (1-800-633-4227). Once you have received your new card, please remember to shred your old one.

REAL ID CARDS

Are you REAL ID compliant? Beginning on October 1, 2020, if you wish to board a domestic flight or enter certain federal facilities, you must have a REAL ID. Standard state licenses will only be valid for driving. Enhanced licenses, which cost an additional \$30, can also be purchased in order to be REAL ID compliant. SOCIAL SECURITY CARD REPLACEMENT

New online services are now available for residents of New York for replacement Social Security number card requests. The <u>portal</u> allows people to replace their Social Security card from home, without having to travel to a Social Security office. If you are a U.S. citizen, are 18 or older and are a resident of New York, you can request a replacement card by creating a My Social Security Account online.

HELP STOP THE LIRR'S FARE HIKE

Last week, I joined Majority Leader Flanagan and the Senate Majority's Long Island Delegation at the Bethpage Train Station to announce our efforts to force the Long Island Railroad (LIRR) to provide fare relief to the region's long-suffering commuters. The MTA continues to make illogical attempts to drive up costs for commuters by proposing a 4% increase in the monthly LIRR commutation ticket. The MTA needs to ensure proper and reliable service before another dollar is taken from Long Island commuters. Despite significant unreliability, equipment failures and delays, they continue to place a tremendous burden on working Long Islanders.
