Dear President Bianco,

I am writing to urge you to restore the portion of the M104 bus line which ran across 42nd Street from Times Square to First Avenue prior to the service cuts MTA New York City Transit implemented in June 2010, and to reverse recent reductions in service on this line.

As you know, the M104 now only travels north-south and terminates at 41st Street between Seventh and Eighth Avenues, depriving riders of a one-seat ride between the Upper West Side and First Avenue and 42nd Street, passing Grand Central Terminal along the way. Thousands of riders who previously took advantage of that convenience must now transfer to a second mode of transportation to get to their final destination, adding time and in some cases expense to the trip. The transfer is a particular hardship for very young, disabled and elderly riders.

I have also been alerted by a number of M104 riders about the adverse impact of recent service cuts. Wait times between buses are now reportedly as long as 20 minutes during normal weekday hours. I hope you will agree that waits of this length on such a heavily used line are excessive. I encourage you to restore more frequent service.
