On June 1, the New York Court of Appeals will hear oral arguments in *Tuck-it-Away v. New York State Urban Development Corporation*. Columbia University wants to expand into Harlem, and take everything in its path. They asked the state to use **eminent domain** to take Nick Sprayregen's storage business, but the New York Appellate Division said NO. The state has appealed to New York's highest court...the same court that rubber-stamped the seizure of Daniel Goldstein's condo for mega-billionaire Bruce Ratner and his playboy Russian business partner. That court will hear the case on June 1.
