SENATE PASSES MONTGOMERY BILL REQUIRING GREATER TRANSPARENCY IN GOVERNMENT SPENDING

Would you like to know how much money NYS is spending in your community and what groups are receiving the support? If Senator Montgomery's bill is signed into law, you will have this information and more! **Under the Senator's bill (S.372-A/A.7993-A), all state agencies will be required to report with much greater specificity on how state resources are spent.** This accounting would be compiled and reported by zip code, types and value of state grants awarded, and by the name of community-based organizations receiving the financial assistance. This reporting method is intended to help create transparency in departmental spending and enable citizens to track the allocation of state dollars earmarked for the betterment of their communities. **Assemblywoman Inez Barron is the sponsor of the bill in the Assembly.**



YES TO RENT REFORM!

The faith-based community from Brooklyn and elsewhere throughout the City stand with Senator Montgomery in calling for the passage of the Omnibus Tenant Protection Bill that extends the rent laws and strengthens rent controls and tenant protections.
