Dear Commissioner Towns:

I am writing regarding the recently issued MCI orders for video intercoms at Stuyvesant Town (Docket # 410093 OM).

The Stuyvesant Town-Peter Cooper Village Tenants Association (ST-PCV TA) brought to my attention an apparent reversible error by the Division of Housing and Community Renewal (DHCR) with respect to issuance of the order.

According to the ST-PCV TA, none of the orders issued acknowledge or consider general and specific objections filed by its attorney, Mr. Tim Collins, with DHCR on May 14, 2012. I urge DHCR to swiftly investigate this claim. If verified, DHCR should promptly rescind the orders and correct its error by considering the ST-PCV TA's objections and giving notice to the owner's attorney.
