On Saturday, September 25, 2010, I honored our local World War II Veterans, who served courageously and sacrificed significantly for our freedom, by Rededicating the World War II Veterans Memorial at Norton Village Park.

Following World War II, many Veterans returned home to an acute housing shortage, including an estimated 30,000 to Rochester. To assist these Veterans, a plan to build three housing complexes with subsidized, quality, rental housing was unveiled — one of the complexes included Norton Village.

I am grateful for the service of our Veterans and I am pleased to be able to honor them by rededicating a monument and the park in their memory. The Veterans Monument will change in the coming months with the addition of bricks, each engraved in the memory of a World War II Veteran.
