Competition Guidelines

Applications and proposals must be received in Senator Smith's District Office by close of business on June 29, 2012. Components of each proposal:

- a. Overview
- b. Plan/Approach (must include precise location, detailed description and timeline)
- c. Budget

NOTE: Obtaining any required permits for your plan are the sole responsibility of the submitting group

Eligibility

You must meet at least one of the following criteria:

- 1. Not-for-Profit 501c3 in good standing
- 2. Registered Block Association
- 3. Existing Civic Association
- 4. Youth Organizations (Boy/Girl Scouts, Explorers, etc.)

Categories and Prizes

This year Prizes will be awarded in the following categories:

Community Beautification- To qualify, individuals within Southeast Queens should expect to make significant improvements to an an area within Queens.

Community Participation- To qualify, individuals within Southeast Queens must directly increase attendance at public meetings.

Before and After Photos For Community Beautification

All applicants in the community beautification competition must take and maintain photos of areas to determine the "before" and "after" images.

Judging and Award

The panel of judges will be comprised of representatives from Community Boards 8,12 and 13.

Maximum Award \$500.
