Dear Neighbor:

On Sunday, March 2, 2014, at 12:30 a.m., a man approached two other men on the platform at the West 4 Street–Washington Square subway station and asked them if they were gay. Both men ignored the question. The man then made a derogatory statement to the men and punched one in his face, causing him to fall to the ground. The perpetrator then fled the station. The victim was treated at Lenox Hill Hospital for a broken nose and a fractured orbital bone.

The perpetrator is described as a white male between the ages of 25 and 30, 5'8" tall, and weighing 170 pounds. A sketch and full description can be found on the opposite side of this letter.



SKETCH OF PERPETRATOR

ON SUNDAY, MARCH 2, 2014, AT 12:30 A.M., THE VICTIM ALONG WITH ANOTHER MALE WERE ON THE PLATFORM AT THE WEST 4 STREET WASHINGTON SQUARE STATION WHEN THE SUSPECT ASKED THEM IF THEY WERE GAY. BOTH MALES IGNORED THE SUSPECT. THE SUSPECT, WHO IS DEPICTED IN THE SKETCH ABOVE, THEN MADE A DEROGATORY STATEMENT TO THE MALES AND PUNCHED THE VICTIM IN HIS FACE, CAUSING HIM TO FALL TO THE GROUND. THE SUSPECT THEN FLED THE STATION. THE VICTIM WAS TREATED AT LENOX HILL HOSPITAL FOR A BROKEN NOSE AND A FRACTURED ORBITAL BONE. THE SUSPECT IS A WHITE MALE BETWEEN THE AGES OF 25 AND 30, 5'8" TALL, WEIGHING 170 POUNDS.
