A. Aurora Historical Museum 300 Gleed Avenue East Aurora, NY 14052 (716) 652-4735

The Aurora Historical Society was founded in 1951 by a group who recognized the importance of preserving our past for the enlightenment and enrichment of future generations. The mission of the Aurora Historical Society is to collect, preserve and interpret the rich heritage of the Town of Aurora.

B. Baker Memorial Methodist Episcopal Church

345 Main Street East Aurora, NY 14052 (716) 652-0500

The Baker Memorial Methodist Episcopal Church moved from its original (1829) building to its present location in 1878. Urged on by young members calling themselves, "The Church of Tomorrow," and supported by the generosity of Carrie Baker Maxwell, the congregation completed its present structure in 1928 and named it for Mrs. Maxwell's father, Chauncey Steele Baker. Baker's sanctuary is known for its 17 Tiffany windows, six of which are signed.

C. The Boston Historical Society Museum

The Boston Historical Society Museum is housed in a building that originally served as The Pioneer Church, which was founded by missionary John Spencer in 1809. 5 years after the first settler arrived in Boston. The building was erected in 1837 and today, nestled among the stately trees and residences in the Town of Boston, it serves as a reminder of the rich and diverse history of the Town. In Boston's early days the back section of the Church was used as the Select School, Artifacts and displays in the museum include information from Dr. Charles Bradley. a resident of Boston who was instrumental in founding the Boston Historical Society in 1963 and became the Town's first official Historian. Historical Marker Signs are placed throughout the Town and lovely countryside pinpointing locations of events significant to the Town's history and providing the opportunity for a wonderful tour, bostonhistoricalsociety@ gmail.com / Facebook- Town of Boston Historical Society

D. Bruce-Briggs Brick Block 5483 Broadway

Lancaster, NY 14086

Bruce-Briggs Brick Block is a historic rowhouse block which incorporates both Greek Revival and Italianate style decorative details and is considered to be a mid-19th century brick structure unique in WNY. The rowhouses were built for George Bruce, one of the early settlers of Lancaster.

E. Buffalo, Rochester and Pittsburgh Railroad Station (Springville, New York)

227 West Main Street Springville, NY 14141

This historic train station was built in 1910 by the Buffalo, Rochester and Pittsburgh Railway.

F. Central Avenue Historic District Lancaster, NY 14086

The Village of Lancaster Historic District has one of the richest concentrations of buildings, commercial and residential, of significant architectural value in Erie County.

G. Citizens National Bank 5 West Main Street Springville, NY 14141 (716) 592-5167

This historic bank was built in 1939 with modern style design elements. The interior features a mural titled "Credit Man's Confidence in Man" and painted by Louis Grell. The building housed a bank until 1968.

H. Clark-Lester House

5454 Broadway Lancaster, NY 14086 (716) 683-3753

This historic home is a Queen Anne style dwelling constructed is 1891. It was home to noted psychology professor Olive Lester, who lived here for most of her adult life. Lester was the first woman chair of any of the departments at the University at Buffalo. It is now operated as the Sassafras Bed and Breakfast.

I. Community of True Inspiration Residence

919 Mill Road

West Seneca, NY 14224

The Community of True Inspiration residence is the best surviving example of a house built by the Community of True Inspiration (the Inspirationists or Ebenezers),

a Christian group that established a distinctive agricultural settlement in the town of West Seneca in 1842. Its distinctive design reflects the groups' principles of common ownership and plain living.

J. Colden Mill Restaurant 8348 Boston Colden Road

The Colden Mill Restaurant strives to make your dining experience one to remember. Once a grain mill dating back to the 1830s, the historic atmosphere combined with the original solid beam construction gives the impressions of a time long past. www.coldenmill.com

K. Depew US Post Office 165 Warsaw Street Depew. NY 14043

This historic post office was designed and built from 1938-1939. It is one of a number of post offices in New York designed by the Office of the Supervising Architect of the Treasury Department, Louis A. Simon. The building is in the Colonial Revival style and the interior features a mural by Anne Poor painted in 1941 and titled "Beginning the Day."

L. Dr. John J. Nowak House 5539 Broadway Lancaster, NY 14086

Dr. John J. Nowak House is a locally significant and distinct example of the Spanish Revival style built for Dr. John J. Nowak in 1930. Several additions were built throughout the years and it is now used as a nursing home.

M. East Hill Historic District, **Springville** 98-367 E. Main Street Springville, NY 14141

The district's residential architecture reflects nearly 100 years of the village's growth. including a variety of residential buildings built between about 1835 and 1935. It includes notable examples of Greek Revival. Italianate, Queen Anne, Colonial Revival, and Bungalow / American Craftsman style architecture.

N. East Main-Mechanic Streets **Historic District**

Springville, NY 14141

East Main-Mechanic Streets Historic District is a 5.5-acre district encompassing 26 contributing structures, which primarily serve commercial functions. Many of structures are in the Italianate style.

O. Eaton Site

West Seneca, NY 14141

Eaton Site is a historic archeological site containing a record of small, intermittently occupied campsites from the Early Archaic through the Late Woodland periods and an Iroquoian village dating to around 1550 AD. The site also contains materials from the

early 19th century, when it was part of the Buffalo Creek Reservation.

Q. Firemen's Memorial **Exhibit Center**

The Firemen's Memorial Exhibit Center of Western New York traces the history of fire fighting in this area with equipment used from the days of the bucket brigades to the motorized vehicles of the present day. The Center also houses rolling stock including five hose carts, a Hook & Ladder Unit, two wheel chemical carts, a 1968 International Chassis with a Darley Body, a 1954 American LaFrance Fireball, a 1932 Buffalo and a 1947

R. First Church of Evans Complex 7431 Erie Road **Derby, NY 14047**

This historic Presbyterian church complex consists of the church, cemeteries, farmhouse (manse), and historic Ingersoll barn with later additions that serve as a community clubhouse. The church is an eclectic Colonial Revival style structure designed by Buffalo architects Mann and Cook and constructed in 1915. The original cemetery includes graves that predates the congregation's founding in 1818.

S. Gamel Hexadecagon Barn **Shirley Road**

North Collins, NY 14111

Gamel Hexadecagon Barn is a historic 16-sided barn built in the Hexadecagon architectural style.

T. George and Gladys Scheidemantel House 363 Oakwood Avevue East Aurora, NY 14052

George and Gladys Scheidemantel House is a locally distinctive example of the Arts and Crafts movement style of architecture built in 1910. It combines elements of the American Foursquare and Craftsman styles. George Scheidemantel was for a time head of the Roycroft Leather Shop and the house designer, William Roth, was head Roycroft carpenter. The house now serves as The Elbert Hubbard Rovcroft Museum.

U. Gravcliff 6472 Old Lake Shore Road Derby, NY 14047 (716) 947-9217

The Graycliff estate was designed by Frank Lloyd Wright and was built between 1926 and 1931. Also called "The Jewel on the Lake", Graveliff is sited on a bluff overlooking Lake Erie with sweeping views of downtown Buffalo and the Canadian shore. Graycliff is one of the most ambitious and extensive summer estates Wright ever designed. www. graycliffestate.org

V. Herman B. VanPeyma House 5565 Broadway

Lancaster. NY 14086

Herman B. VanPevma House is a historic home and an example of the eclectic architecture featuring the Queen Anne style. built circa 1890. It was built for Herman Boetkhout VanPeyma, an early Dutch immigrant to the Town of Lancaster.

W. John P. Sommers House 33 Lake Avenue

Lancaster, NY 14086

John P. Sommers House is a historic home built in 1906 in Queen Anne style.

X. John Richardson House 5653 Broadway

Lancaster. NY 14086

John Richardson House is a historic home and a distinct example of the vernacular interpretation of Italianate style. It was built in 1840 by John Richardson, a local brickmaker and builder.

Y. Kazoo Factory, Museum, and Gift Shop of Eden

8703 South Main Street Eden. NY 14057 (716) 992-3960

The Original American Kazoo Company was established in 1916 and is now the only metal kazoo factory in North America. The museum highlights history, trivia, and shows step-by- step the way kazoos are made. This working museum continues to manufacture a complete line of kazoos. www.edenkazoo.com

Z. Knox Farm State Park 437 Buffalo Road

East Aurora, NY 14052 (716) 549-1802

Knox Farm State Park is the former country estate of Buffalo's renowned Knox Family. The park's 633 acres are comprised of a variety of habitats, including 400 acres of grasslands and 100 acres of woodlands, ponds and several wetland areas. Visitors to Knox Farm can observe wildlife, hike, cross-country ski and ride horseback along beautifully scenic nature trails. www.parks.ny.gov/parks/163

AA. Lancaster District School No. 6 3703 Bowen Road Lancaster, NY 14086

The Lancaster District School No. 6, also known as the Little Red Schoolhouse, was constructed in 1868 according to the reform ideals of the mid-19th century. The school was used from 1868 to 1948 when it was closed due to the centralization of all Lancaster schools. In the 1950s and 1960s it was used as a polling location until it was

BB. Lancaster Masonic Lodge Hall 5497 Broadway Lancaster, NY 14086

The Lancaster Masonic Lodge Hall is a locally distinctive example of the Neo-Classical Revival style of architecture. It was built between I916 and I919 as a meeting hall for the local Masons and today, it is used as a commercial office building.

CC. Lancaster Municipal Building 5423 Broadway Lancaster, NY 14086

The Lancaster Municipal Building is a historic municipal building, built in 1940. It is an example of the modern style of design and also as an example of the work of Buffalo architects Hudson and Hudson. It has served as the center of the Village of Lancaster government since 1940.

DD. Lancaster US Post Office 5064 Broadway

Lancaster, NY 14086

This historic post office was designed and built from 1938-1939. It is one of a number of post offices in New York designed by the Office of the Supervising Architect of the Treasury Department, Louis A. Simon. The building is in the Colonial Revival style and the interior features a mural by Arthur Getz painted in 1940 and titled "Early Commerce in

the Erie Canal Region."

EE. Liebler-Rohl Gasoline Station 5500 Broadway

Lancaster, NY 14086

The Liebler-Rohl Gasoline Station is a historic filling station and Lancaster's sole example of historic 20th century roadside commercial architecture. It is in the Tudor Revival style of architecture and was operated as a gasoline station until the I960s. It currently operates as a seasonal ice cream shop, known as Frosty's.

FF. Millard Fillmore House

24 Shearer Avenue East Aurora, NY 14052 (716) 652-4735

The Fillmore House was the residence of the I3th President of the United States, Millard Fillmore. Fillmore built this house in I826 and lived there only four years during which time his son was born. Besides the White House, it is the only surviving structure of residence for President Fillmore. It is open to the public from June through October on Wednesdays, Saturdays and Sundays from I-4.

GG. Miller-Mackey House 5440 Broadway Lancaster, NY 14086

The Miller-Mackey House is a locally distinctive example of the Colonial Revival style of architecture from the early 20th century. The property enjoyed a long association with two locally prominent families who were active both in medicine and in the commercial life of the community. The Boys' and Girls' Club has used the property as a recreational and social facility for the area's young people.

HH. Newton-Hopper Village Site Elma, NY 14059

The ancient grounds were the location of a Seneca village and burial grounds more than 200 years ago. Humans have lived at the site for approximately 4,000 years, archaeologists believe. In recent times it has been a working farm in the Newton-Hopper family. It is believed that the grounds contain the burial plot of Seneca Indian Chief Big Kettle, leader of the tribe following the death of Chief Red Jacket in 1830.

II. Old Sardinia Town Hall 12070 Savage Road Sardinia, NY 14134

Old Sardinia Town Hall, also known as the Sardinia Meeting House and First Baptist Church of Sardinia, is a historic town hall that is now home to the Sardinia Historical Society and Museum.

JJ. Pioneer Cemetery

West side of N. Main St. between Gold Street & Beach Road

Evans Center, NY 14006

Pioneer Cemetery, also known as Evans Center Cemetery, is a historic cemetery consisting of IO to II rows of burials, with the oldest dating to I8IO. The majority of the burials date between I8IO and I860, with the most recent burial in I928. Most are marked with simple tablet headstones.

KK. Rider-Hopkins Farm and Olmsted Camp 12820 Benton Road Sardinia, NY 14134

Rider-Hopkins Farm and Olmsted Camp is a historic farm and summer camp containing a Greek Revival style brick farmhouse dating to the I840s known as the James and Abigail Hopkins House. The property retains its original boundaries as purchased from the Holland Land Company in I828. It is also the site of the Olmsted Camp - a turn of the 20th century family summer camp in the Adirondack "Great Camp" tradition. The camp buildings are in the Arts and Crafts style and grounds are laid out in a naturalistic manner.

LL. Roycroft Campus 31 South Grove Street East Aurora, NY 14052 (716) 655-7252

The Roycroft Campus was a reformist community of craft workers and artists which formed part of the Arts and Crafts movement in the United States. Elbert Hubbard founded the community in 1895 in the village of East Aurora. Participants were known as Roycrofters and the work and philosophy of the group, often referred to as the Roycroft movement, had a strong influence on the development of American architecture and design in the early 20th century.

MM. Schoolhouse #8 History Center & Museum 2101 School Street North Collins, NY 14111 (716) 337-3341

Schoolhouse #8 History Center & Museum is dedicated to preserving this one-room rural schoolhouse, complete with period appropriate furnishings, teaching aids, and memorabilia. The best way to experience the many education changes is for current and future generations to visit and be able to see and touch a real, restored, rural school like the one in which many of their ancestors were educated.

00. Springville US Post Office

75 Franklin Street Springville, NY 14141

This historic post office was designed and built from 1938-1939. It is one of a number of post offices in New York designed by the Office of the Supervising Architect of the Treasury Department, Louis A. Simon. The lobby features a mural by Victoria H. Huntley painted in 1938. and titled "Fiddler's Green."

PP. Warren Hull House

5976 Genesee Street Lancaster, NY 14086 (716) 681-6451

The Hull House, built in I8IO by Warren Hull, is the oldest stone dwelling in Erie County and is a rare piece of early American architecture. It is currently being restored by the Hull House Foundation as an educational and interpretive center for early 19th century life in the WNY frontier. It is a rare surviving example of Federal style architecture in the Niagara Region and is purported to be the oldest substantial stone dwelling in Erie County.




Zuidema-Idsardi House is a historic home and a distinct example of the vernacular interpretation of Italianate style, incorporating elements of Eastlake Movement ornamentation. It was built for John H. Zuidema, a local Dutch businessman, circa 1876.

RR. Boston Free Library

The Boston Free Library building was originally constructed around 1930 and served as a one room school house until the building became the Boston Free Library in 1955.







A - Arcade and Attica Railroad

278 Main Street

Arcade, NY 14009

Incorporated in 1917, the Arcade & Attica Railroad is a short line railroad that hauls freight between Arcade and North Java. The railroad originally connected Arcade with Attica, however the right of way from North Java north to Attica was abandoned in 1957 due to flooding on the Tonawanda Creek. www.arcadeandatticarr.com

B - Arcade Center Farm 7298 NY 98

Arcade, NY 14009

Arcade Center Farm is a historic home and farm complex. Its Greek Revival-style frame structure was built around 1835. The farm occupies 59 acres and, in addition to the farmhouse, includes a historic 19th century harn.

C - Arcade Historical Society

331 Main Street Arcade, NY 14009 (585) 492-4466

The Society was originally formed in 1957 as the Arcade Sesquicentennial and Historical Society for the 150th anniversary of the settlement of the town. The AHS is dedicated to collecting and preserving objects, records, and other artifacts that illustrate the history of the Town of Arcade and the surrounding area. www.arcadehistoricalsociety.org

D - Attica Market and Main Historic District

2-28 & 19-45 Market Street, 2-10 & 21-39 Main Street

Attica, NY 14011

The Market and Main District is a commercial core of 23 buildings dating from 1827 to 1915 and represents the village's growth resulting from industrial development along the intersection of major transportation routes. The resulting growth helped lead to the development of the Exchange District, which captures Attica's history as a railroad boomtown.

E - Attica US Post Office

76 Main Street Attica, NY 14011

This historic post office building was designed and built in 1936-1937 as a Works Progress Administration project, and is one of a number of post offices in New York designed by the Office of the Supervising Architect of the Treasury Department, Louis A. Simon. The building is in the Colonial Revival style and the interior includes a mural painted in 1938

by Thomas Donnelly and titled "Fall in the Genesee Country".

F - Augustus A. Smith House 125 Main Street

Attica, NY 14011

Augustus A. Smith House, also known as Germain House, is a large, irregularly massed Queen Anne style residence constructed in 1890.

G - Brick Presbyterian Church

6 Church Street Perry, NY 14530

(585) 237-2726

Brick Presbyterian Church is a Gothic Revival style church built in 1909 of random ashlar Pennsylvania limestone. It is a product of the Buffalo architectural firm of Green & Wicks.

H - Bryant Fleming House

1024 Tower Road

Wyoming, NY 14591

Bryant Fleming House is a historic home built in 1850 and is a vernacular Italianate-style cottage. Another main building is a multipurpose "playhouse" designed for large-scale entertaining and accommodation of overnight guests. The property includes notable landscape features that its principal owner Bryant Fleming designed and installed after he purchased the property about 1910.

I - Epworth Hall

Perry Avenue

Perry, NY 14530

Epworth Hall is a historic assembly hall built in I892 in the Colonial Revival style. It is the largest of three such halls on the grounds of the Silver Lake Institute, a Methodist-affiliated camp facility established in I873.

J - Exchange Street Historic District

15-48 Exchange Street & Erie RR Depot Attica, NY 14011

Exchange Street Historic District is a national historic district encompassing twelve contributing buildings along two blocks in the village of Attica. They are brick and frame commercial buildings built after the fire of 1877. The buildings provided service and hospitality for rail passengers and for cultural and social events for Attica's citizens. They include the Williams Opera House (1879), Wyoming House (1878), Hotel Liberty or Attica Hotel (c. 1880), The Railroad Store (c. 1885), Erie House (1880), Spann Block (1874),

Western Hotel (1832), and Erie Depot (1879).

K - First Free Will Baptist Church of Pike

72 Main Street

Pike, NY 14130

First Free Will Baptist Church of Pike is a historic Baptist church built in 1881 in a Late Victorian Gothic style. A baptistry was added in 1917 and a rear addition in 1926.

L - First Methodist Episcopal Church of Perry

35 Covington Street

Perry, NY 14530

First Methodist Episcopal Church of Perry, now known as Perry United Methodist Church, is a historic Methodist Episcopal church. The Gothic Revival style church is home to a Methodist congregation dating to 1816.

M- First Universalist Church of Portageville

E. Koy Road at NY 19A Portageville, NY 14536

First Universalist Church of Portageville, also known as The Portageville Chapel, is a historic Universalist church. It has a Greek Revival style structure with Gothic and Federal elements dating to 1841.

N - Java School No. 1 NY 78

Java Village, NY 14083

Java School No. I is a historic school built in the Italian Villa style. It was built about I850 and operated as a school until I967. In I969, the building was occupied by the local Grange and now also houses the Java Historical Society Museum, a local history museum that is open by appointment.

O - Letchworth State Park

Genesee River Gorge Bet. Portageville and Mt. Morris

Genesee Falls, NY 14536 (585) 493-3600

Letchworth State Park, renowned as the "Grand Canyon of the East," is one of the most scenically magnificent areas in the eastern U.S. Hikers can choose among 66 miles of hiking trails. Trails are also available for horseback riding, biking, snowmobiling and cross-country skiing.

P - Middlebury Academy

22 S. Academy Street

Wyoming, NY 14591

Middlebury Academy is a historic school, which was erected by the citizens of Wyoming in 1817. This Greek Revival style structure was originally sponsored by the Baptist Church until the academy became a Union Free School in 1880 and operated as a school until 1912. It is now home to the Middlebury Historical Society.

Q - Monument Circle **Historic District**

East Court St. from North, Main Street to Park Street and adjacent parts of Main and Park Warsaw. NY 14569

Monument Circle Historic District is a national historic district which consists of 18 acres and includes a broad range of architecturally significant resources. It encompasses twentyone late 19th and early 20th century civic, religious, and domestic properties. Highlights include the Soldiers and Sailors Monument (1876-1877). Warsaw Public Library (1905). Augustus Frank House (1849-1850), Wyoming County Courthouse (1937), County Sheriff's Office and Jail (ca. 1901), and United Methodist Church (1901–1902).

R - Perry Downtown Historic District

North & South Main, Covington, & Lake Streets, Borden Avenue Perry. NY 14530

Perry Downtown Historic District is a national historic district encompassing 41 contributing buildings in the village of Perry. They are a variety of commercial, institutional, and governmental buildings with most built between 1850 and 1918. They include the Town Hall (1909), Masonic Temple (1914), Bussey Block (1898), Bailey-Roche Block (c. 1836), A. Cole and Wygant Building (1867), Garrison Building (1901), Rufus Smith Block (1856), Howell Building (1895), Traver Place Apartments (1924), and the Wise Building (1903).

S - Seth M. Gates House

Seth M. Gates House was built in 1824 and expanded in 1843. Its owner from about 1843 until his death was Seth M. Gates, who served in the U.S. House of Representatives from

1838 to 1842. From the time of his purchase and for the next 15 years, the house was a station on the Underground Railroad with gates concealing the fugitives in the cellar and attic. From 1893 to 1924, it was home to the Society of Village Works, a local charitable organization.

T - Silver Lake Institute **Historic District**

46 Wesley Road

Silver Lake, NY 14549

Silver Lake Institute Historic District is a national historic district consisting of I3 acres and is historically significant because of its association with the Silver Lake Institute, a Methodist affiliated camp facility established in 1873. The properties reflect the evolution of the institute from a Methodist Revivalist summer camp in the 1870s and 1880s to a cultural, educational, and religious summer institute in the Chautauqua tradition during the I880s and I890s, and finally to a secular summer cottage community in the early 20th century. The focal point of the community is Burt Park and the district includes 72 additional properties including 70 cottages.

U - Trinity Church

62 West Buffalo Street

Warsaw. NY 14569

Trinity Church, also known as Trinity Episcopal Church, is an historic Episcopal church built in 1853-1854. This Gothic style frame church closely follows the plan and elevations of a country church published by Richard Upjohn in his book Upjohn's Rural Architecture. Upjohn's connection with the design of the church has been confirmed by a letter dated December 30, 1853. www.trinitywarsaw.org

V - Warsaw Academy

73 S. Main Street

Warsaw. NY 14569

Warsaw Academy is a historic school built in the Greek Revival style. Built as a school in 1846, the building has housed a Masonic temple since 1907.

W - Warsaw Downtown Historic District

North & South Main between Frank & Brooklyn **Streets**

Warsaw, NY 14569

Warsaw Downtown Historic District is a national historic district encompassing thirty-six contributing buildings in the village of Warsaw. They are a variety of commercial. institutional, and religious buildings with most built between the I870s and I915. A number of commercial buildings were constructed after the fires of 1867 and 1887. They include the Andrew Jackson Warner designed United Church of Warsaw (1860s). First Baptist Church (1889), Bartlett Block (1866, 1890), Hostetter's Pharmacy (1888). New Watkin's Hotel (1888) Sullivan Building (1915), Wyoming County Bank (1905), Glover's Department Store (1916), Gardner's Grocery (1860-1870), Pratt Grocery (1870), Farman-Humphrey Block (1884), Lincoln Block (1894-1900), and Schwab's Motor Sales (1940).

X. Warsaw US Post Office

35 S. Main Street

Warsaw, NY 14569

This historic post office building was designed and built in 1934-1935 as a Works Progress Administration project, and is one of a number of post offices in New York designed by the Office of the Supervising Architect of the Treasury Department, Louis A. Simon.

Y. Wyoming Village Historic **District**



Wyoming Village Historic District is a national historic district organized much like a New England village around a small triangular village green. The district includes approximately 70 structures along the two principal streets, Main and Academy Streets. The most dominant structures are the Presbyterian Church (1830), "Fire Tower" (1902), Village Hall (1902), and Middlebury Academy.

A - Aaron Barber Memorial Building

143 Genesee Street

Avon. NY 14414

Also known as the Avon Free Library, the Aaron Barber Memorial Building, is a historic library building. It was built in 1928 in the Colonial Revival style.

B - Asahel Warner House 7/36 W. Main Street

Lima. NY 14485

Asahel Warner House is a historic home built in 1810. It was remodeled in the 1860s and in 1907 and features Italianate details. A third floor attic contains a Masonic Lodge meeting room with paneling dated to 1907. Also on the property are a contributing barn, shed, and chicken coop.

C - Avon Five Arch Bridge

2078 Avon Geneseo Road Avon, NY 14414 (585) 243-7010

This bridge was built in I856-I857 by the Genesee Valley RR in order to span the Conesus Outlet. This limestone bridge was part of the Rochester-Avon-Geneseo-Mt. Morris line, which was electrified in I907. In I941 the Avon – Mt. Morris section was abandoned and the rails removed. The bridge is in excellent condition, but not connected to a rail line.

D - Avon Inn 55 E. Main Street Avon, NY 14414 (585) 226-8181

Built in 1820 in the Greek Revival style, the Avon Inn is an historic sanitarium. Several expansions were made, including the Colonial Revival style dining room in 1912. It currently operates as a restaurant, banquet hall, and an inn for any type of getaway.

E - Barber-Mulligan Farm

5403 Barber Road Avon. NY 14414

Barber-Mulligan Farm is a historic farm that includes a number of the original buildings, examples of late Greek Revival architecture, as well as many improvements. The most important cluster is the central farm complex that includes the main house, a carriage house, horse barn, and corncrib, all built in 1852 by Aaron Barber.

F - Barnard Cobblestone House 7192 W. Main Street Lima. NY 14485

Barnard Cobblestone House is a historic cobblestone home built in the late Federal and early Greek Revival style. A remodeling in the 1880s added Queen Anne style details including the verandah. Also on the property is a 19th-century carriage barn.

G - Big Springs Museum

3095 Main Street Caledonia, NY 14423 (585) 538 9880

The Big Springs Museum's collection is comprised of objects that reflect the history of the Caledonia-Mumford community The collection includes an emphasis on the area's rural, agriculture character and the lives of the residents. The collection includes examples of Caledonia's Seth Green Fish Hatchery, military artifacts and memorabilia, items pertaining to public education and local spiritual life, toys, paintings and folk art, Native American artifacts, natural history collections, and an extensive costume and textile collection.

H - Black and White Farm Barn 7420 Dansville-Mt. Morris Road, NY 36 Sonyea, NY 14556

Black and White Farm Barn is a historic barn built in 1884 on a 600-acre farm. The barn, designed by architect Joseph Cone, also features a central courtyard.

I - Boyd & Parker Park and Groveland Ambuscade

US 20A; Gray Hill Road Cuylerville, NY 14481

Boyd & Parker Park and Groveland Ambuscade is a historic park area consisting of two sites. The sites commemorate the Boyd and Parker ambush, which took place during the Sullivan Expedition of the American Revolutionary War in September 1779.

J - Bristol House 1950 Lake Avenue Lima, NY 14485

Bristol House is a historic home built between 1870 and 1875 and is a two-story Italianate style frame dwelling.

K - Caledonia House Hotel 3141 State Street

Caledonia. NY 14423

Caledonia House Hotel, also known as the Masonic Temple, is a historic hotel constructed in 1831-1833 of cut-stone in the Federal style. Built originally as a hotel and used as such through the 19th century, the structure now houses two commercial spaces on the first floor and the local masonic temple on the second and third floors.

L - Caledonia Library

3108 W. Main Street Caledonia. NY 14423 (585) 538-4512

The Caledonia Library is a historic library building established in 1873. It is still currently operating as the library in Caledonia.

M - Cargill House **1839 Rochester Street** Lima. NY 14485

Cargill House is a historic home built in 1852 and is an elegant, Greek Revival-style brick dwelling. Also on the property is a carriage barn, two cut-stone hitching posts, and a spring-fed pond.

N - Clark Farm Complex 7646 E. Main Road Lima, NY 14485

Clark Farm Complex is a historic home, constructed in the early 1830s, and farm complex. It is a large working farm composed of a mid-19th century farmhouse and full complex of farm related support structures. There are twelve related farm dependencies including a well house, smoke house, privy, garage, and chicken house.

O - Clark-Keith House 3092 Main Street

Caledonia, NY 14423

Clark-Keith House is a historic home constructed of cut stone in the Federal style. The structure was built in 1827 and has housed a tavern, post office, the village library, banks, and insurance agents. Since the 1920s, it has been used as a residence.

P - Corby Farm Complex 7400 Corby Road

Honeoye Falls, NY 14472

Corby Farm Complex is a historic farm complex consisting of the farmhouse and a garage, smokehouse, pump house, clothes drying pole, privy, barn, two silos, and gate posts The farmhouse was built in the mid-19th century and remodeled in 1877 and again about 1900.

Q - Coverdale Cobblestone House 2049 Coverdale Road Leicester. NY 14481

Coverdale Cobblestone House is a historic home, which was completed in 1837. It was built in the late Federal and early Greek Revival style and features medium-sized cobbles in its construction.

R - Dayton House 7180 W. Main Street Lima, NY 14485

Dayton House is a historic home built in 1844 and was expanded and upgraded in the I850s and I860s. It has Greek Revival form and an overlay of Italianate and Gothic Revival design elements. Also on the property is a large carriage house, smoke house, and original cast iron lamppost.

S - Delaware, Lackawanna & **Western Railroad Station**

South Park Dr.

Leicester, NY 14481

Delaware, Lackawanna & Western Railroad Station is a historic railway station built in 1915 in the Arts and Crafts style.

T - DePuy, William House

1825 Genesee Street

Lima, NY 14485

William DePuy House is a historic home built in 1851 with vernacular Greek Revival and Gothic Revival design elements.

U - **D**raper House 1764 Rochester Street Lima. NY 14485

Draper House is a historic home built in 1842 and remodeled in the 1860s with vernacular Italianate style design features.

V - First Methodist Episcopal **Church of Avon** 130 Genesee Street

Avon. NY 14414

First Methodist Episcopal Church of Avon, also known as Avon United Methodist Church, is a historic Methodist Episcopal church designed by Rochester architect James Goold Cutler. This Romanesque-style brick building was built in 1879.

W - First Presbyterian Church of Avon

5605 Avon-Lima Road East Avon. NY 14414

First Presbyterian Church of Avon is a historic Presbyterian church built in the Federal style. Construction of the building started in 1812 and it was dedicated in 1827. In 1866, the existing church was renovated and the present tower added.

X - Ganoung Cobblestone **Farmhouse**

2798 Popular Hill Road

Lima. NY 14485

Ganoung Cobblestone Farmhouse is a historic home constructed in the 1830s in the late Federal and early Greek Revival style. Also on the property is a 19th-century carriage barn, small shed, and a well with pump.

Y - Genesee Wesleyan Seminary and Genesee College Hall **College Street**

Lima, NY 14485

These two historic buildings are located on the campus of Elim Bible Institute. The Genesee Wesleyan Seminary building, a neoclassical-style brick structure, was constructed in 1842 and now serves as the college Administration Building. The Genesee College Hall was completed in 1851 and is a complete neoclassical temple form.

Z - Geneseo Historic District

Main Street from the courthouse at Court and **North Streets**

Geneseo. NY 14454

The district includes Geneseo's historic commercial center and its most refined residential neighborhood, plus the estate of the Wadsworth family. The district consists of 312 properties, of which 288 are currently contributing.

AA - Godfrey House and Barn Complex

1325 Rochester Road Lima, NY 14485

Godfrev House and Barn Complex is a historic home and barn complex built in 1853. In addition to the Italianate-style farmhouse. there are four contributing buildings and two structures dating from the I850s to the 1930s. They include two barns, a milk house, a chicken house, garage, and a silo.

BB - Hall's Opera Block

15-19 Genesee Street Avon. NY 14414

Hall's Opera Block, also known as Clark's Opera House and Avon Opera Block, is a historic commercial building that was completed in 1876 in the Italianate style. The top floor performance space was a central gathering place for the community, where citizens of all ranks could congregate to attend theatrical performances, lectures, dances, political meetings, and school graduations.

LIVINGSTON COUNTY

CC - Harden House 7343 E. Main Street Lima. NY 14485

Harden House is a historic home built in 1885 and is a two-story frame dwelling in the Queen Anne style. Also on the property is a 19th-century carriage house.

DD - Hillcrest 7242 W. Main Street Lima. NY 14485

Hillcrest is a historic home constructed in I838-I840. Stylistically, the house is a combination of Federal and Greek Revival design. Also on the property is a gazebo constructed from the remains of the privy and carriage barn.

EE - J. Francis Kellogg House 255 Genesee Street Avon, NY 14414

J. Francis Kellogg House is a Colonial Revival–style dwelling with Arts and Crafts influenced detailing constructed in 1908. It was designed by architect Claude Bragdon.

FF -. J. Franklin Peck House 7347 E. Main Street Lima. NY 14485

J. Franklin Peck House is a historic home built in 1853 in the Greek Revival-style by architect J. Franklin Peck.

GG - Leech--Lloyd Farmhouse and Barn Complex 1589 and 1601 York Street

Lima, NY 14485

Leech-Lloyd Farmhouse and Barn Complex is a historic home built in 1800 and dates to the settlement period. The barn complex was demolished in May 1989.

HH - Leech-Parker Farmhouse 1537 York Street Lima. NY 14485

Leech-Parker Farmhouse is a historic home built in 1800 in a New England building tradition. Also on the property are a privy and well dating from the 19th century.

II - Lima Village Historic District

1881--1885 & 1818--1870 Rochester Street, Lima Presbyterian Church, 7304--7312 & 7303--7315 E. Main Street Lima, NY 14485

Lima Village Historic District is a national historic district encompassing 2I commercial, religious, civic, and residential properties in the historic core of the incorporated village of Lima and centered on the Four Corners business district. The buildings date from 1845 to 1923.

JJ - Linwood 1912 York Road York, NY 14592

Linwood, also known as the Gratwick Estate, is a national historic district, census-designated place and farm. The district is a 350-acre site with twelve buildings, nine sites, four structures, and two objects.

KK - Livingston County Historical Society

30 Center Street Geneseo, NY 14454 (585) 243-9147

The Livingston County Historical Society is an educational institution whose purpose is to present, promote, preserve, and value the rich history of Livingston County. The District #5 Union School, built in 1838, houses the LCHS because James and William Wadsworth donated this land to remain forever a site for educational purposes.

LL - Markham Cobblestone Farmhouse and Barn Complex 6857 Heath--Markham Road

Lima, NY 14485

Markham Cobblestone Farmhouse and Barn Complex is a historic home and barn complex constructed in 1832 in the late Federal and early Greek Revival style. Also on the property are a full complement of outbuildings dating from the 19th and early 20th century, including three contributing barns, a shed, two silos, a well with pump, and the remains of a former barn.

MM - Martin Farm Complex 1301 Bragg Street Lima. NY 14485

Martin Farm Complex is a historic home and farm complex consisting of a gentleman farmer's Italian villa farmhouse along with a full complement of contributing agricultural outbuildings. In addition to the farmhouse, there is a brick office building, milk house, sheds, privy, carriage barn, chicken house, four barns, a pergola, smoke house, cast iron fence, stepping stone, and two hitching posts.

NN - Matthew Warner House 7449 E. Main Street Lima. NY 14485

Matthew Warner House is a historic home built in 1806. It was remodeled in the 1860s and the 1920s. The 1860s remodeling resulted in the picturesque Gothic- Italianate character. The house was used as an inn in the early 19th century and as a roadside restaurant in the 1930s.

OO - Morgan Cobblestone Farmhouse 6870 W. Main Road Lima. NY 14485

Morgan Cobblestone Farmhouse is a historic home constructed in 1832 in the late Federal and early Greek Revival style. Also on the property is a historic hitching post.

PP - National Hotel 2927 Main Street Cuvlerville, NY 14481

National Hotel is a historic hotel built in 1841 in the Federal and Greek Revival–style. It was reputedly a station on the Underground Railroad.

QQ - National Warplane Museum 3489 Big Tree Lane Geneseo, NY 14454 (585) 243-2100

The 1941 Historical Aircraft Group, now known as the National Warplane Museum, was established in 1994 by an initial band of 250 aviation enthusiasts. The primary goal is to maintain the traditional airshow held on the turf strip at the Geneseo airport and to highlight the aircraft of the past with a focus on World War II aviation.

RR - Ogilvie Moses Farmhouse 2150 Clay Street Lima. NY 14485

Ogilvie Moses Farmhouse is a historic home built during the I830s with vernacular Greek Revival style features. Contributing structures on the property are a smokehouse and the remains of a root cellar.

SS - School No. 6

6679 Jenks Road Lima, NY 14485


School No. 6 is a historic school building constructed in 1843. This vernacular Greek Revival school closed in 1943 and converted to a residence after 1953.

TT - Sparta First Presbyterian Church

4687 Scottsburg Road Groveland, NY 14462

Sparta First Presbyterian Church is a historic Presbyterian church, constructed in 1915-1916 with a simple but sophisticated combination of Arts and Crafts principals and freely styled Tudor Gothic detailing executed with modern building materials.

UU - Spencer House 7372 E. Main Street Lima, NY 14485

Spencer House is a historic home believed to date to the I830s and then enlarged in the I850s and I860s. The main block evinces the persistence of Federal period architectural traditions. Also on the property is a contributing 19th century carriage house.

VV - Stanley House 7364 E. Main Street Lima, NY 14485

Stanley House is a historic home built in 1857 in Greek Revival style. Also on the property is a contributing 19th century carriage house and privy.

WW - St. Rose Roman Catholic Church Complex

Lake Avenue

Lima, NY 14485

St. Rose Roman Catholic Church Complex is a Roman Catholic church complex consisting of four contributing buildings: St. Rose Church, constructed 1870-1873; Brendan Hall, constructed in 1894 as a parochial school; the rectory; and the convent.

YY - Thomas Peck Farmhouse 7955 E. Main Road Lima. NY 14485

Thomas Peck Farmhouse is a historic home built in 1812 and was remodeled between 1860 and 1880. This is a Federal style stone building with late 19th century Italianate and Gothic Revival inspired design features. Also on the property is a privy, an ice house, a guest / tenant house, and the remains of a former barn complex.

ZZ - Wadsworth Homestead NY 39 and U.S. 20A Geneseo, NY 14454 (585) 764-9005

Also known as "The Homestead", this elegant manor house was built by the Wadsworth family in 1804, and remains in their ownership today. Original furnishings and ephemera are part of the unique appeal of this venue that is now open to the public for weddings, celebrations, and events. www.wadsworthhomestead.com

BBB - William Harmon House 1847 Genesee Street Lima. NY 14485

William Harmon House is a historic home built in 1851 and is a Gothic Revival style board-and-batten cottage in a cruciform plan. The exterior and interior of the home feature rich Gothic orgamentation.

CCC - William L. Vary House 7378 E. Main Street

Lima. NY 14485

William L. Vary House is a historic home built in 1885 in the Queen Anne-style designed by the Pierce Brothers.

DDD - Williamsburg Cemetery Abel Road

Hampton Corners, NY 14462

Williamsburg Cemetery is a historic cemetery established in 1792 and is one of the earliest European American settlement period cemeteries and is the last surviving above ground remnant of Williamsburg. Williamsburg was established by Captain Charles Williamson who was acting in his capacity as agent for British investors in the late 18th century. Notable burials include U.S. Representative Charles H. Carroll and William Fitzhugh, Colonel Nathaniel Rochester, Henry Fitzhugh, and James G. Birney. Stones bear dates that range from 1814 to 1910.

EEE -Zebulon Moses Farm Complex 2770 Clay Road Lima. NY 14485





A - Antoinette Louisa Brown Blackwell Childhood Home

1099 Pinnacle Road Henrietta, NY 14467

The Antoinette Louisa Brown Blackwell Childhood Home is a vernacular Federal style masonry residence constructed in I830. It is notable as the childhood residence of women's rights advocate Antoinette Brown Blackwell, who was the first woman to be ordained as a minister in the United States.

B - David McVean House

805 North Road Scottsville, NY 14546

David McVean House, also known as the McVean-Jones-Reeves House, is a brick vernacular Federal-style house on a pargeted cut-stone foundation.

C - Donald Mann House

327 Stewart Road Scottsville, NY 14546

Built in I830, the Donald Mann House is associated with the early settlement of Scottish immigrants recruited by Captain Charles Williamson. Donald Mann and his wife, Margaret, were part of the early Scottish settlement, buying land in East Inverness (Wheatland) around I810. The house built is a good representative example of a Federal style stone house built of locally quarried stone

D - First Baptist Church of Mumford

5 Dakin Street Mumford, NY 14511

First Baptist Church of Mumford was built in 1852, and is a vernacular Greek Revivalstyle frame church building on a cobblestone foundation. Minor expansions and alterations were done to the building through 1917.

E - First Presbyterian Church of Mumford

George and William Streets Mumford, NY 14511

First Presbyterian Church of Mumford is a High Victorian Gothic-style edifice built in 1883 of rare bog limestone.

F - Florendin Feasel House 1294 Lehigh Station Road

Henrietta, NY 14467

Records show the Feasel House was built around 1866 and when owned by Florendin Feasel, the property was a 35-acre farm adjacent to a large dairy operation. The dairy closed in the 1950s and the farm acreage was reduced to slightly over half an acre by subsequent owners responding to development pressures. The property retains its rural character largely due to a creek, plantings and a town park created on the

former dairy lands, which create a barrier

between the development and the house.

G - Grace Church

9 Brown's Avenue Scottsville, NY 14546

Grace Church is a historic Episcopal church designed by noted Rochester architect Harvey Ellis and built in 1885. It is in the Latin cross form in the Richardsonian Romanesque style. Attached is a Sunday school wing constructed in 1956 and a square, shingled bell tower added in 1976. It is a congregation in the Episcopal Diocese of Rochester.

H -Isaac Cox Cobblestone Farmstead

5015 River Road Scottsville, NY 14546

Isaac Cox Cobblestone Farmstead, also known as the Letson Farm, is a historic home and farm complex, which includes a Federal style cobblestone farmhouse built about 1838. Also on the expansive property are a pair of Wells truss barns, 19th century combination corn crib / pig sty, and small 19th century smokehouse.

I - New York Museum of Transportation

6393 East River Road West Henrietta, NY 14586 (585) 533-1113

The New York Museum of Transportation is open all year on Sundays only, from Ilam to 5pm. The museum's exhibit spaces feature a collection of antique trolley cars, a steam locomotive, fire truck, ambulance, operating model railroad, many other vehicles, and numerous exhibits of photographs and artifacts pertaining to local transportation history.

J - Oatka Cemetery

411 Scottsville-Mumford Road Wheatland, NY 14546

The Oatka Cemetery is an intact settlement era burial ground that provides information about the earliest citizens of the area cemetery, which serves as the final resting place of the village of Scottsville's early settlers, from its first burial in I8IO. Still active, the Oatka Cemetery has a high degree of integrity, especially in terms of location, setting, design, feeling and association.

K - Rochester Street Historic District

Both sides of Rochester Street Scottsville, NY 14546

Rochester Street Historic District is a national historic district encompassing 41 residential structures, over half of which date from the I830s through I850s and are distinct examples of Greek Revival architecture.

L - Romanta T. Miller House

1089 Bowerman Road Wheatland, NY 14546

Romanta T. Miller House was built from I869-I870 for successful farmer, Civil War Veteran and town assessor Romanta Miller. The distinctive brick home was a statement of a family's evolution from its pioneer beginnings in the early I9th century to that of wealthy estate owners by the turn of the 20th century.

M - Simeon Sage House

69 Main Street Scottsville, NY 14546

Simeon Sage House is a historic home built around 1830 in a vernacular Federal style. There are later Greek Revival style modifications. It is an example of a working man's cottage and serves as home to the Wheatland Historical Association.

N - Tinker Cobblestone Farmstead 1585 Calkins Road Henrietta NY 14467

Tinker Cobblestone Farmstead, also known as the Tinker Homestead and Farm Museum, is a Federal style cobblestone farmhouse built between 1828 and 1830. It is one of 13 surviving cobblestone buildings in Henrietta. Much of the surrounding land is now the Tinker Nature Park with hiking trails and a nature center. The house now serves as a museum.

O - Union Presbyterian Church Church Street

Scottsville, NY 14546

Union Presbyterian Church, also known as First Presbyterian Church of Wheatland, is a historic Presbyterian church. It is a mid-19th-century vernacular Romanesque Revival-style building that houses classrooms, offices, and kitchen facilities.

P - William Shirts House

196 Harmon Road Scottsville, NY 14546

William Shirts House, also known as Camperdown Farm, is a vernacular Federalstyle house, which was built around 1825.

Q - Windom Hall

28 Main Street Scottsville, NY 14546

In the late 1880's, the activity and enthusiasm of the Scottsville Dramatic Club indicated a need for a theater in the community. By 1891, James H. Kelly purchased the home of early settler, William H. Hanford, and architect Charles Ellis of Rochester designed the building to become a community hall. Windom Hall became the meeting center for many groups in the community.
