It is budget season in Albany, and this year's initial proposals bring some real risk for the senior centers in our community. As you know, these are critical services -- and they rely on state funding.

Under the preliminary state budget proposal, \$17+ million in state dollars would be redirected away from senior centers and other services -- without any replacement funds to fill the gap. This could have significant impacts at centers like this one.

I am fighting to ensure senior centers and other crucial programs are fully funded -- but I need your help. In addition to directly sharing your feedback with me and your other elected officials, I am hoping you can sign this petition to ensure senior centers are fully funded. I will keep fighting for our senior services, as well as for increasing funding for other important programs like Settlement Houses, NYCHA, and Community Services for the Elderly.
