Tips to Avoid Deed Fraud

- Make sure the <u>New York City Department of Finance</u> has the correct mailing address for you or the person who should receive notices about your property.
- Register for the New York City Department of Finance's <u>Recorded</u>
 <u>Document Notification Program by visiting the Automated City Register</u>
 <u>Information System (ACRIS)</u> so that you can receive an alert when a deed, deed-related document, mortgage, or mortgage-related document has been recorded against your property.
- Check the <u>City Register's records</u> periodically to ensure that no deeds or mortgages have been recorded on your property without your consent.
- Contact the Department of Finance if you stop receiving property tax bills and the <u>Department of Environmental Protection</u> if you stop receiving water bills.

Don't know who your Senator is?

- ② Click on their name, and then click on "Contact" to get their phone number
- Gall them! Leave a voicemail if no one answers

Key Points for your call or voicemail

- Mention that you are their constituent
- Tell them you want them to support the deed theft package:
- Bills <u>S.605A@</u>; <u>S.7647@</u>; <u>S.7491A@</u> and <u>S.7721/A8863@</u>
- You can leave it at that, or share any personal feelings or experiences in support of the bill

Example

"Hi, my name is John Doe and I live in your district. I'm calling to ask you to support the Deed Theft package S.605A; S.7647; S.7491A and S.7721/A8863

[Share 2-3 sentences about YOUR issues with deed theft. If you don't have a direct issue you can simply say why you support the Deed Teft Package]

"I didn't know anything about deed theft until I got an eviction notice for my own home of 30 years that's bought and paid for! I found out that someone I don't even know, had their name on my deed! This is not right. We need Deed Theft laws now!"
