Dear Member of the Legislature,

The jury verdicts finding two former legislative leaders guilty of using their office for personal gain have underscored the urgent need for significant reform to our state's ethics laws. More than ever, New York needs good elected officials, like yourself, to step forward, and separate themselves from the tarnished legacy of their former legislative leaders. Our groups have joined together to call on our elected representatives and leaders to continue the job of reforming our laws governing public cthics. We urge you to work with your colleagues to embrace real solutions by enacting legislation that will bring about largescale change instead of incremental reform.

We ask all of our elected legislative representatives and the Governor to sign the following Clean Conscience Pledge:
