Memory Screening Process

- A memory screening is a first come, first served simple and safe evaluation to check memory and other thinking skills. It can indicate whether a follow up with a healthcare professional is needed.
- The face-to-face screening takes place in a private setting. Only the individual being tested and the screener are present and takes approximately 10 minutes.
- A screening consists of a series of questions and/or tasks designed to test memory, language skills, thinking ability, and other intellectual functions.
- Results of the memory screenings are confidential. The participant will receive the screening results to bring to a healthcare professional for follow-up if necessary.
