COMMITTEE JURISDICTION AND OVERVIEW

The New York State Senate Standing Committee on Investigations and Government Operations has legislative oversight responsibilities for issues concerning oversight of our state government, including proactively investigating and exposing waste, fraud, and abuse. The Committee's purview covers sections of the Alcoholic Beverage Control law, Arts and Cultural Affairs law, Civil Rights law, Executive law, Indian law, Legislative law, Public Authorities law, Public Buildings law, Public Lands law, Public Officers law, State law, Tax law, and Office of General Services land transfers in Unconsolidated law.

During the 2023 Legislative Session, 407 bills were referred to the Committee for its review. Of these bills, 171 were reported from the Committee. 146 were passed by the Senate, and 121 passed in both houses. This work was conducted through a series of 5 Committee meetings. A list of all bills that were reported from the Committee is provided at the end of this report.

In addition to its regular meetings, the Committee held two hearings. Topics of these hearings included videoconferencing by the legislature and issues in the New York State market related to consumer accessibility and retail sale of legal adult-use cannabis. Further, the Committee published an investigative report regarding unessential financial assistance provided by Industrial Development Agencies.

COMMITTEE HIGHLIGHTS

The following key bills were acted on by the Committee in 2023:

S2854 (Skoufis) / A7305 (Cunningham) - Chapter 525 of the Laws of 2023

Relates to the hours during which liquor and/or wine stores may be open on Sunday This law authorizes liquor and wine stores to open on Sundays as early as 10am and remain open until 10pm.

S3567A (Skoufis) / A6050A (Bronson) - Chapter 526 of the Laws of 2023

Permits the sale or promotional gifting of certain complementary products for wine and spirits This law allows liquor and wine stores to sell complementary gifts and promotional items associated with wine and spirits.

S5731 (Skoufis) / A6941 (Bronson) - Chapter 524 of the Laws of 2023

Permits the sale of beer at retail on Sundays; repealer

This law allows the retail sale of beer for off-premises consumption between the hours of 3am and 8am on Sundays.

S50 (Hoylman-Sigal) / A1025 (Bichotte-Hermelyn) – Chapter 373 of the Laws of 2023

Prohibits the sale of tobacco products at vending stands or in vending machines in state buildings This law adds consistency to other state laws and policies, regarding tobacco cessation and the promotion of health, by prohibiting the sale of tobacco products in state buildings.

S291 (Tedisco) / A1347 (Buttenschon) – Chapter 619 of the Laws of 2023

Establishes a veteran internship program (V.I.P. NY)

This law establishes a veterans internship program (V.I.P. NY) by awarding ten percent of available internships in the Assembly youth participation program and the Senate student program to eligible honorably discharged veterans.

S3364 (Scarcella-Spanton) / A2902 (Cunningham) – Chapter 522 of the Laws of 2023

Relates to the utilization of a pressurized mixing and dispensing system

This law permits a retail licensee for on-premises consumption to prepare and keep drinks containing alcoholic beverages in dispensing machines, having a capacity of not less than a gallon, utilizing a pressurized mixing and dispensing system.

S1290 (Hinchey) / A5116 (Gunther) - Passed Senate Only

Relates to a state flag for raising awareness of veteran suicide

This bill would provide that the "Suicide Awareness and Remembrance Flag" shall be the official state flag for the raising of awareness of veteran suicide and directs the commissioner of general services to establish a protocol for the flying of such flag.

S2722 (Skoufis) / A7392 (Bronson) – Passed Senate Only

Establishes a temporary New York craft beverage permit

This bill would allow licensed New York State farm distilleries, breweries, cideries, wineries, or meaderies to apply for temporary 24-hour permits for on-premises consumption at gatherings, functions, and other events.

S6785A (Skoufis) / A7509 (Bronson) - Reported from Committee

Makes major revisions to provisions of the alcoholic beverage control law relating to the issuance of licenses and hours of operation; repealer

This bill would modernize and simplify the state's alcohol laws in accordance with recommendations made by the Commission to Study Reform of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Law.

S2852A (Skoufis) / A3132A (Lupardo) – Reported from Committee

Authorizes the direct intrastate and interstate shipment of alcoholic beverages This bill would allow direct-to-consumer shipping of liquor, cider, mead, and braggot by New York's licensed manufacturers of alcoholic beverages.

TWO HOUSE BILLS

In 2023, 121 of the 407 bills referred to the Standing Committee on Investigations and Government Operations passed both houses of the Legislature. Of these bills, the Governor has signed 117, vetoed 1, and 3 remain to be acted on.
