

2018 Rules Report

The Rules Committee reported 1,198 bills from committee this session. Of these 1,198 bills, 0 were referenced to a committee of secondary reference and did not advance further. A total of 1,198 bills advanced to Calendar, 600 of which died on 3rd Reading Calendar, while 414 bills passed the Senate only and 184 bills passed both Houses.
