COMMITTEE JURISDICTION AND OVERVIEW

The New York State Senate Standing Committee on Rules has wide discretion over bill review. This Committee has jurisdiction over various areas of New York law. The Committee on Rules may sit at any time and report bills out of committee which have been referred to Rules from any other Committee including bills which may be referenced to this committee upon introduction. During the 2019 Legislative Session, 1266 bills were referred to the Committee for its review. Of these bills, 1119 were reported from the Committee. 839 bills were passed by the Senate, and 511 passed in both houses. This work was conducted through a series of 29 committee meetings.
