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COMMITTEE JURISDICTION AND OVERVIEW

The New York State Senate Standing Committee on Rules has wide discretion over bill review. The Committee has jurisdiction over various areas of New York law. The Committee on Rules may sit at any time and report bills out of committee which have been referred to Rules from any other Committee including bills which may be referenced to this committee upon introduction.

During the 2021 Legislative Session, 1261 bills were referred to the Committee for its review. Of these bills, 724 were reported from the Committee, 661 were passed by the Senate, and 468 passed in both houses. Of these 468 bills, 5 were concurrent resolutions to amend the State Constitution, 422 have been signed into law, 12 have been vetoed, and 29 are awaiting Executive action. The committee's work was conducted through a series of 16 meetings.
