INTRODUCTION OF ALL RESOLUTIONS

To introduce this resolution:

WHEREAS, the Governor was given the authority pursuant to section 28 of the Executive Law, on his own initiative or pursuant to a request from one or more chief executives, finds that a disaster has occurred or may be imminent for which local governments are unable to respond adequately, he shall declare a disaster emergency by executive order; and

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WHEREAS, Executive Order number 202, declared a disaster emergency in the State of New York in response to the novel coronavirus, COVID-19 outbreak as a public health emergency; and

WHEREAS, the Governor subsequently issued 109 successor executive orders to Executive Order 202, issuing directives, modifying and suspending statutes, local laws, ordinances, orders, rules and regulations touching every part of New Yorkers' way of life; and

WHEREAS, during the onset of the pandemic it was appropriate for the Governor to declare a disaster emergency in order to quickly respond to the growing crisis; and

WHEREAS, since the rollout of the extremely effective COVID-19 vaccines, infection rates across the state have plummeted to below 1%; and

WHEREAS, the restrictions on businesses and New Yorker's way of life have been lifting slowly, such as the mask mandate and occupancy requirements within businesses; and

WHEREAS, the infection levels have reached a low enough level that the Governor no longer needs complete control over the State's response to COVID-19 and the State Legislature must reassert itself into the decision making process; and

WHEREAS, the State Legislature has the authority to terminate by concurrent resolution a state disaster emergency issued under section 28 of the Executive Law, chapter 23 of the laws of 2020 and chapter 71 of the laws of 2021; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, (if the concur), That the state disaster emergency issued by the Governor under Executive Order number 202, as extended or modified, is hereby terminated.
