

Dear Governor Cuomo:

I write on behalf of communities in my district that have experienced severe rainstorms, producing floods and destruction to both public and private property.

Specifically, communities I serve in Cayuga, Cortland, Chenango and Herkimer Counties, to a greater or lesser extent, have witnessed loss of public infrastructure and many homeowners are suffering from repeated flooding.

For homeowners, as you know, insurance policies do not generally cover flooding, For municipal official replacing culverts and repairing roads, budgets limited by property tax levy cap do not allow for the additional expense they are incurring as they recover from the rains. Municipal officials are using their budgets simply to repair damage, lessening funds otherwise available for ordinary road and bridge repairs.

I appreciate the assistance of DHSES in assisting communities tally their damage.

However, I write to ask that the state provide immediate assistance to local governments and to assess how to assist property owners with damage to their property, homes, and businesses.

Thank you for your assistance in this critical issue to out mutual constituents.
