

**ACKNOWLEDGMENT AND AGREEMENT OF NONDISCRIMINATION  
IN THE PROVISION OF MEDICAL SERVICES**

The New York City Human Rights Law (the “NYCHRL”) prohibits discrimination in public accommodations, including parks and hospitals, because of any person’s actual or perceived race, creed, color, national origin, age, gender, disability, marital status, partnership status, sexual orientation, uniformed service or alienage of citizenship status. *See* N.Y.C. Admin. Code § 8-107(4). In addition, New York State regulations require every hospital in New York to afford to each patient the right to treatment without discrimination as to race, color, religion, sex, national origin, disability, sexual orientation, age, or source of payment. *See* N.Y. Comp. Codes R. & Regs. tit. 10, § 405.7(b)(2).
