Spray Park Grand Opening Celebrated at Ossining's Louis Engel Waterfront Park

(Ossining, NY) – The Town of Ossining unveiled a new splash pad at the Spray Park at the Louis Engel Waterfront Park on Friday.

The new splash pad debuted this summer season, and it quickly became a community favorite for families and children during the warm weather.

In advance of the last weekend of summer, the Town and Senator David Carlucci (D-Westchester/Rockland) highlighted this new community asset with an official grand opening.

The new splash pad was made possible with a State Capital Grant secured by Carlucci for \$100,000. Town officials thanked him for the State funds to complete the project.

Ossining Town Supervisor Dana Levenberg said, “We are so grateful to Senator Carlucci for helping us get this state money to upgrade our Town’s wonderful spray park to make it safer and more inviting for our children. It is a great place for all in our community to come together and enjoy a cool reprieve on a hot summer day, no matter what their financial situation might be. We couldn’t be happier with this beautiful spot.”

This spray park will offer a fun, safe, and free option for families to enjoy and visit. I am proud to have secured the funding and to work with the Town of Ossining to see this project to fruition.”
