Call for Proposals

SHIRLEY CHISHOLM SCULPTURE



UNBOUGHT AND UNBOSSED

This sculpture will demonstrate Shirley Chisholm's incredible legacy to the entire Western New York community and beyond: who she was and what she meant and her impact on her community and constituents.

REQUIREMENTS

- Materials can either be Barre grey granite, bronze, or a combination of both. Barre grey granite may be polished, unpolished, thermal finished, or a combination.
- Memorial size is not to exceed 7' total height from the level of the earth by 10' total width, left to right, including the base.
- Statue should be figurative and vertical in orientation.
- The selected site is 6 feet from the sidewalk in front of Birchwood Mausoleum.
- Statue will have a granite base on a concrete foundation.



THE SITE



ELIGIBILITY

- This request for proposals is open to all artists or artist teams working in New York State, with a preference for Western New York.
- Artists submitting qualifications should demonstrate a level of experience and professionalism that is commensurate with the project scope and budget.
- Preference will be given to artists/artist teams who self-identify as Artists of Color.
- Artists are not required to be producers of sculpture material and may work in conjunction with a producer to be identified by the committee upon selection.

APPLICATION PROCESS: PHASE 1

- Artist's CV and/or website.
- Up to 8 digital images (TIFF or JPEG) of artworks that communicate the quality and characteristics of the sculpture if commissioned. (These images can include past work as reference.)
- Sketches indicating the general characteristics of the proposed commissioned artwork.
- Proposal narrative of up to two pages describing the intent, characteristics, material, scale, any required care and maintenance, and a description of the applicant's connection to the subject matter; specifically why being involved in this project is meaningful for their work.
- A **preliminary budget** listing fabrication and design costs, artist fee, shipping and installation, and self-insurance costs. The budget should demonstrate the applicant's ability to outline stages in the process toward a completed project, and estimate costs thoughtfully.

APPLICATION PROCESS: PHASE 2

Up to two selected artists will receive a stipend of \$1,500 to complete the Phase II application process. For Phase II, the artist will submit:

- Up to two maquettes that may be contained in 2' x 2' x 2' display cases.
- Detailed budget including estimated fabrication and design costs, artist fee, shipping, installation, and self-insurance costs. Artist(s) must connect with Tom Koch at Stone Art for his estimate per Forest Lawn requirements.
- A production schedule including installation time.
- Statement of intention that, should the artwork be selected and paid for, copyright will be transferred to Forest Lawn Cemetery.
