Dear Governor Cuomo:

As the State Senator representing the 54th Senate District, I respectfully request and urge you to reconsider the proposed reduction of almost \$240 million in funding for the Office of People With Developmental Disabilities (OPWDD).

Non-profit providers of residential services, care coordination organizers, direct support professionals and families of those with intellectual and developmental disabilities have brought to my attention the extreme consequences that would result from these reductions.

These residences and services are vital to these vulnerable groups and those that care for them and simply cannot afford to be cut. Funding cuts will lead to a lesser quality of life and could mean the closure of many facilities that have been considered essential during the COVID-19 pandemic.

Prior to being elected State Senator, I began my career as a direct care worker. I know firsthand the issues that face our patients, aides, nurses and other caregivers and the much needed services that OPWDD provides for our vulnerable population.
