SENATOR SAMPSON URGES PARTICIPATION IN THE UPCOMING HEARING NOTICE ON PROPOSED WASTE TRANSFER STATION IN CANARSIE

On January 13, 2009 New York State Department of Environmental Conservation will hold a hearing on a proposed waste transfer station to be located at 100-02 Farragut Road off Rockaway Parkway in Canarsie. This proposal would allow CMW Industries to construct and operate a 15-ton per day regulated medical waste transfer station and would also allow for the transfer of up to 350 gallons per day of conditionally exempt hazardous waste. This waste could potentially be stored for up to 10 days at the facility.

I strongly urge you to attend and participate in this hearing. Tell the D.E.C. that we don't want our community to be exposed to medical waste and hazardous waste! WE CAN MAKE A DIFFERENCE!! By standing together as a united community we can let the Administrative Law Judge and the Department of Environmental Conservation know that we don't want 17 truckloads of waste per day every day travelling through our neighborhoods and being stored, even temporarily near our homes and businesses.
