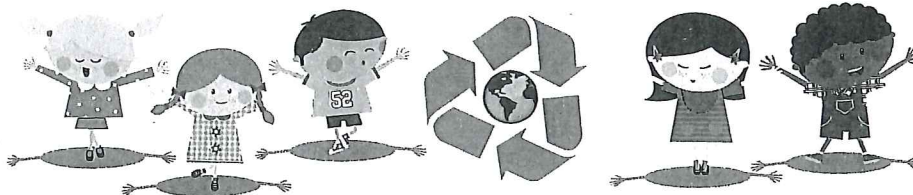


New York State Senate Earth Day Competition 2017 Poster Contest
