For instance, in the website [www.bhg.com](http://www.bhg.com) says that "Brown" materials include dried plant materials; fallen leaves; shredded tree branches, cardboard, or newspaper; hay or straw; and wood shavings, which add carbon, for best results, start building your compost pile by mixing three parts brown with one part green materials, sprinkle water over the pile regularly so it has the consistency of a damp sponge, in addition to aerating regularly, chop and shred raw ingredients into smaller sizes to speed up the composting process and add about 4 to 6 inches of compost to your flower beds and into your pots at the beginning of each planting season." This is important because you do not want to overdo anything and will mess up the compost.
