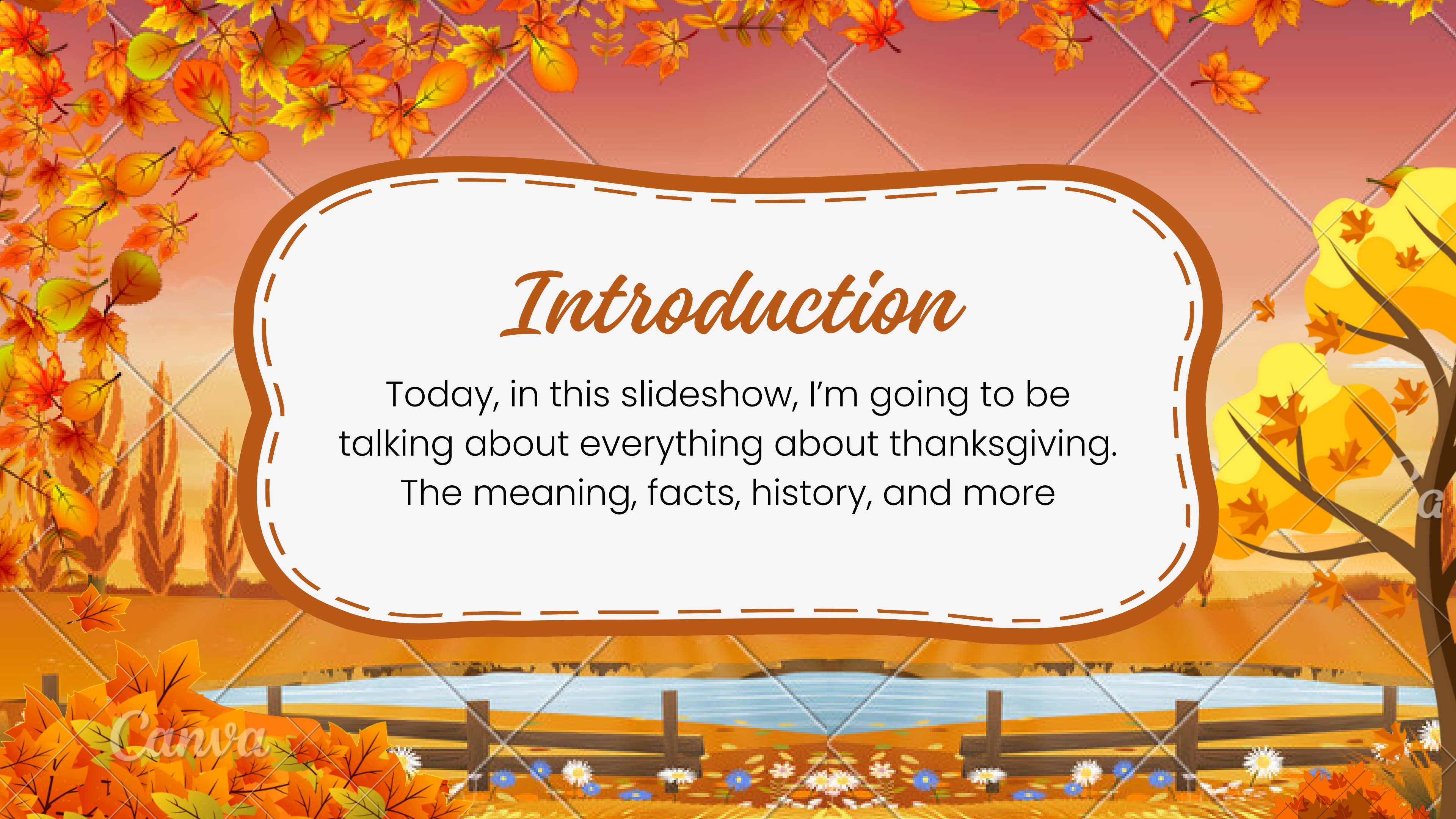

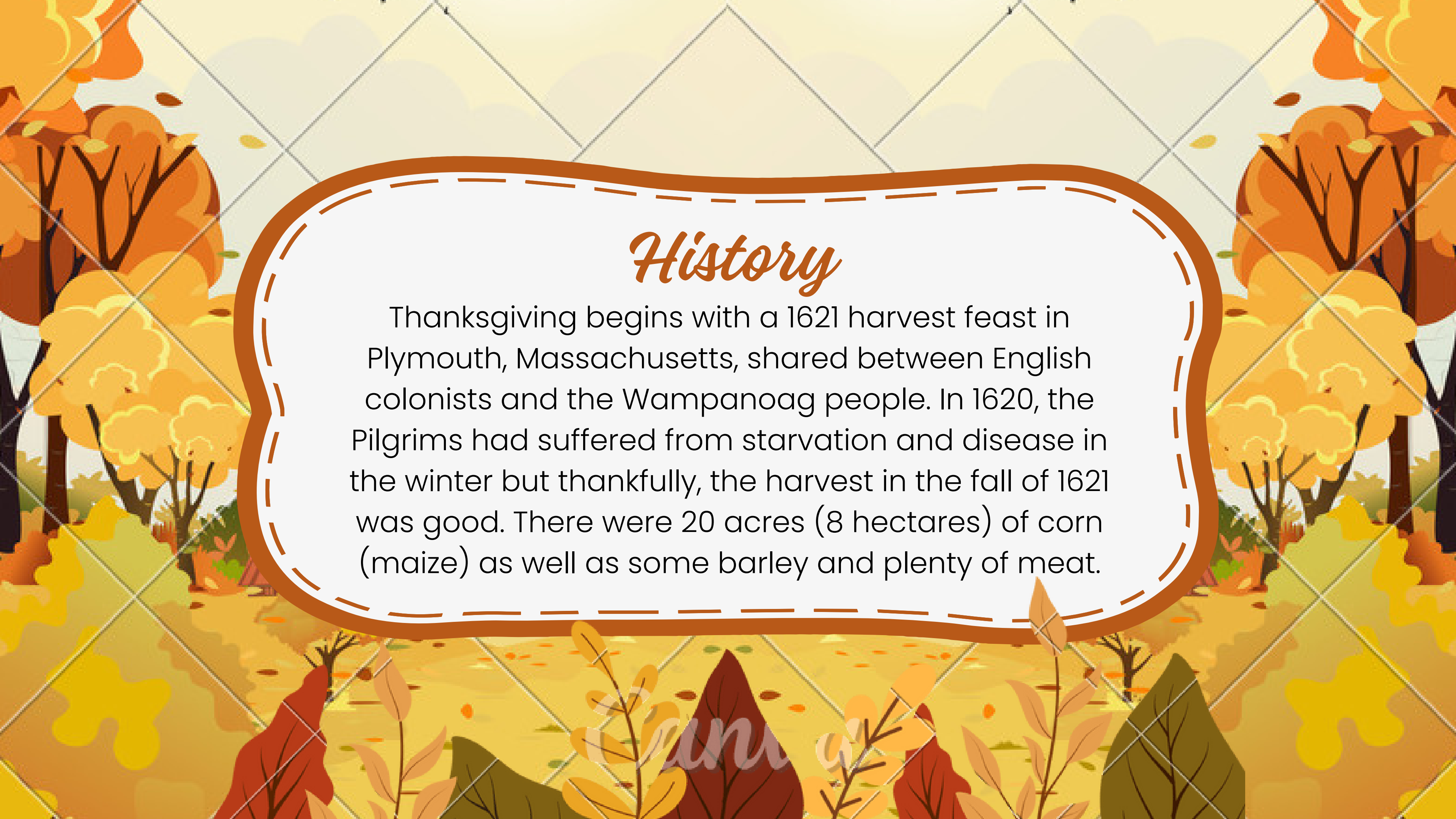

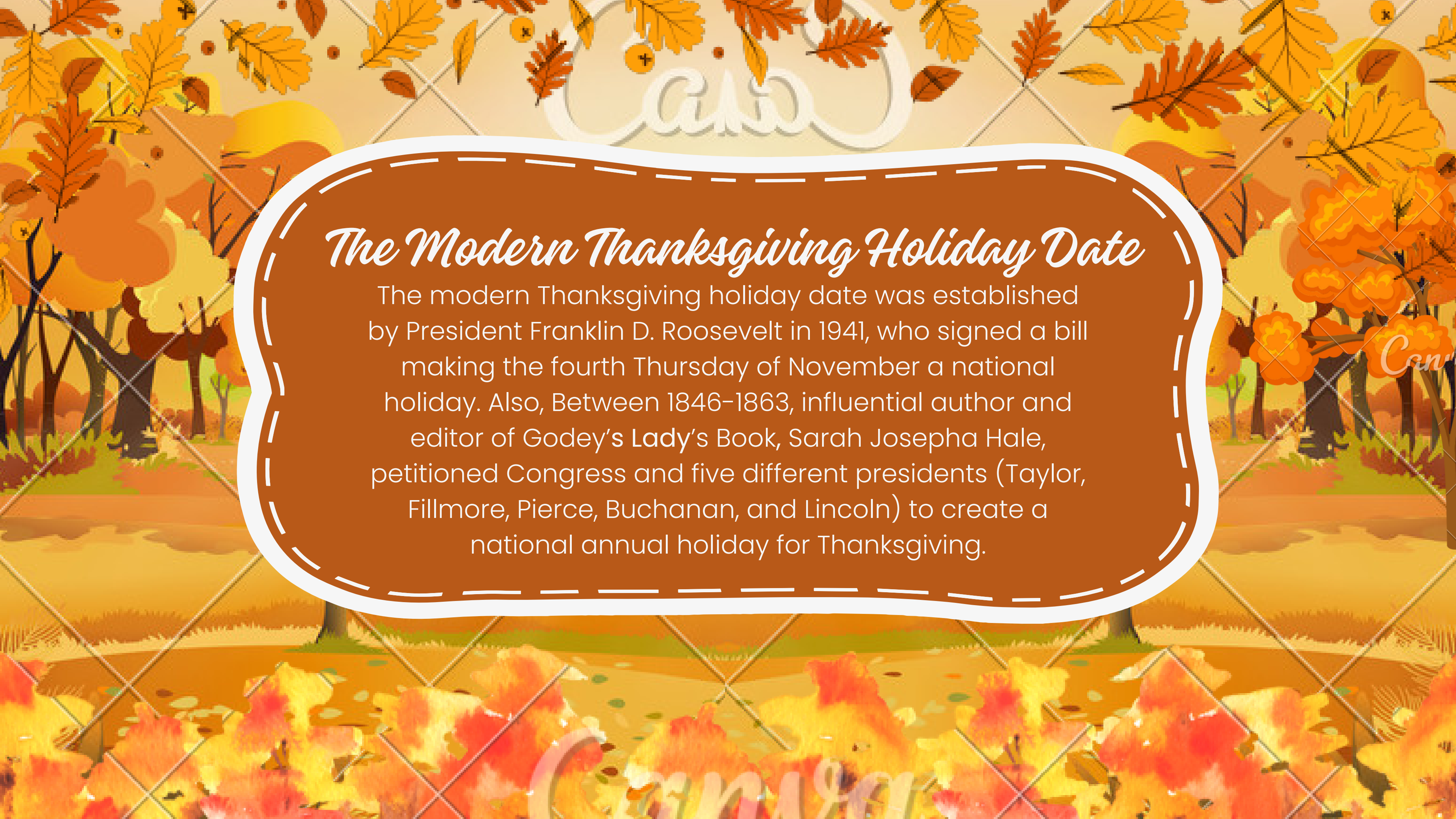

History

Thanksgiving begins with a 1621 harvest feast in Plymouth, Massachusetts, shared between English colonists and the Wampanoag people. In 1620, the Pilgrims had suffered from starvation and disease in the winter but thankfully, the harvest in the fall of 1621 was good. There were 20 acres (8 hectares) of corn (maize) as well as some barley and plenty of meat.



The Modern Thanksgiving Holiday Date

The modern Thanksgiving holiday date was established by President Franklin D. Roosevelt in 1941, who signed a bill making the fourth Thursday of November a national holiday. Also, Between 1846–1863, influential author and editor of Godey's Lady's Book, Sarah Josepha Hale, petitioned Congress and five different presidents (Taylor, Fillmore, Pierce, Buchanan, and Lincoln) to create a national annual holiday for Thanksgiving.

Traditions mostly include spending time with your family, eat some thanksgiving foods, watch some football and/or parade, play board games, and say what your thankful for.
